Treasury: Kathleen Abernathy reports \$721.10 in the banking account and no incoming checks from National from dues. The Board approved the following statement regarding expenses made by any member of the Sun Cities/West Valley NOW Board or by chapter members on behalf of the organization.

Statement regarding Expenditures:

Expenditures require prior approval by the Co-Coordinators, unless made as "In-kind." No expenditures will be paid without documentation (i.e., receipts, etc.). Treasurer is to be advised so that a check can be written

in a timely manner. A budget should be prepared in advance of future WHM events/or other special events. As of December 2018, printing will be reimbursed at the prevailing rate (Staples) of \$0.12 cents per page black and white and \$0.61 cents per page for color.

Kathleen also prepared a projected budget that was approved by the Board Members in attendance. Additionally, a budget plan must be made for our major events that need money, such as WHM. This budget must be worked out and approved BEFORE the event. This received unanimous consent from the board.

ERA Lynne and Kathleen attended a meeting (as part of a large coalition of women) of the ERA TASK FORCE. There were 25 Women attending the meeting: 5 from Tucson, Multiple groups attending. This meeting was to plan for education of the public and legislators that adoption of the ERA amendment is needed. The meeting lasted for two hours with Diane Post coordinating volunteers to achieve each task that was decided on. We will receive our tasks soon. Our January meeting is dedicated to this, with Diane Post as our speaker. At this time, Lynne will be our chapter's lead person on ERA. Doreen and Kathleen will back her up. One of the things considered is having an ERA Presence every day of the legislature.

Future Meetings
