Minutes Member Meeting Nov 6, 2019

Laura, our lobbying person, gave a quick update on the Vital Visions organization. The group recruits women in leadership positions around the world to fight for women's rights and collaborates with women in leadership to "make the world a better place" through democracy, leadership, collaboration, and advocacy.

Dianne Post with the ERA Taskforce gave an update on what is going on with the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) efforts.

The State of Virginia just elected a Democratic majority so it is expected that they will vote on ratification of the ERA on Feb. 12th, 2020, and it is expected to pass. This will make VA the 38th state to ratify the ERA.

The AZ ERA Taskforce has spent the summer going to events across the state to educate people on the ERA and gain support for it. They got 91 cities/towns with the League of City and Towns to formally support the ERA except for Phoenix, who refused. It was estimated only 27% of AZ knew the ERA was a thing and 80% of people think it already passed.

Things we can do to help with the ERA effort:

- Sign letters to remove/extend the deadline for ratification of the ERA and send them to Sinema, McSally, and Lesko.
- Get churches and businesses to sign letters of support for the ERA.

There will be an event "Unlock the Future": on December 8th at the Capitol in the Rose garden from noon to 2. This is a NOW sponsored event and a national NOW representative will be there. The event is focused on the current situation at the U.S. southern border and the impact on women and girls.

The ERA Taskforce will be focusing on educating people vs. lobby a lot in 2020. It will still be difficult to pass the ERA in AZ unless we get new people in the legislature. The group will continue fighting until the ERA is passed in AZ.

There will be an event, “Unlock the Future,” to work for immigrant rights on December 8th in the Rose Garden at the Capitol. Attendees will be asked to bring used clothing, toiletries, and sanitary products for women. They will be asked to support the Bill of Rights for People in Immigration Detention Prisons. More information will be coming out. There will be an Unlock the Future event in San Diego, Houston, and Phoenix in 2020.
